She is the youngest Professional Engineer and only the third woman to advance in this position since the Society's founding in 1934.

Ms. Verhalen is an associate in the Energy Section at the law firm of Briggs and Morgan, P.A where she works with many Professional Engineers, Engineers-in-Training, and engineers on large energy infrastructure projects both from a regulatory and an environmental perspective. Prior to joining Briggs, she was an environmental engineer for a Minnesota electric utility company.

Since 2001 she has been an active member of both the Minnesota Society of Professional Engineers (MnSPE) and NSPE. She started MnSPE's first student chapter at the University of Minnesota-Duluth. A year after college graduation she was elected to the MnSPE Executive Committee advancing to the position of MnSPE president in 2010. Her leadership roles with NSPE have included membership on the Board of Directors and House of Delegates, chairman of the Membership Committee, the Bylaws Review Task Force, and the Position Statement and Professional Policy Development Task Force.


